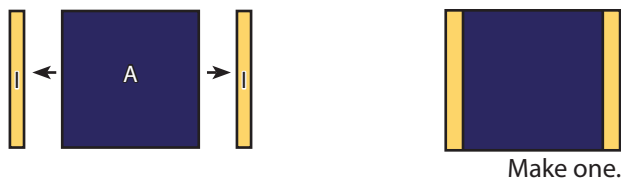
Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

Band Unit:

Assemble two Fabric I rectangles and the Fabric A square.

Fabric I/A/I Unit should measure $7\frac{3}{4}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$.

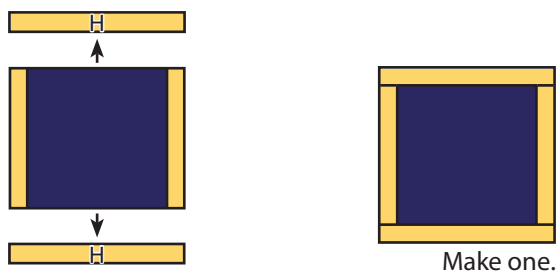
Make one.



Assemble two Fabric H rectangles and the Fabric I/A/I Unit.

Center Ring Unit should measure $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$.

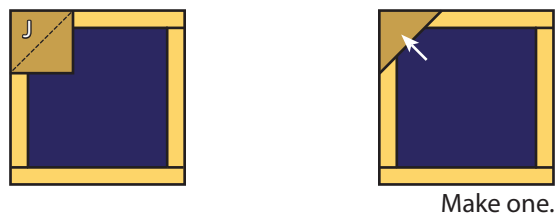
Make one.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric J squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric J square on one corner of the Center Ring Unit.

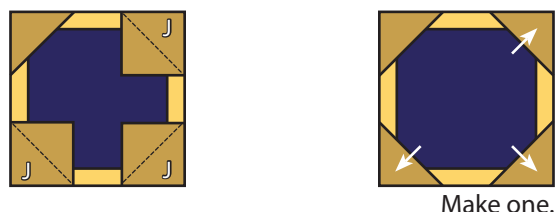
Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from the seam.



Repeat on the remaining corners of the Center Ring Unit.

Partial Band Unit should measure $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$.

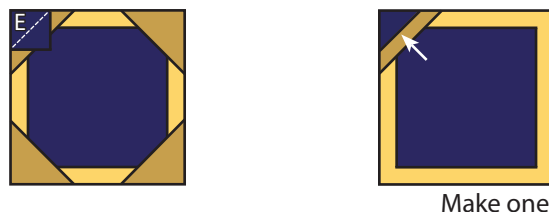
Make one.



Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric E squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric E square on one corner of the Partial Band Unit.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from the seam.



Repeat on the remaining corners of the Partial Band Unit.

Band Unit should measure $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$.

Make one.



Diamond Row:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric F squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F square on the left end of the Fabric R rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from the seam.

Fabric F/R Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{5}{8}"$.

Make one.



With right sides facing, layer a Fabric F square on the right end of the Fabric M rectangle.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from the seam.

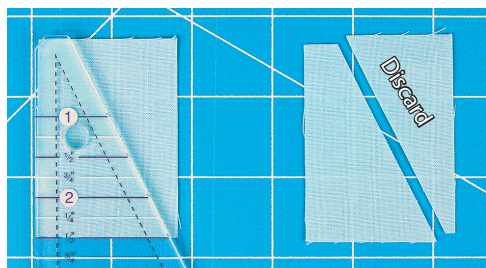
Fabric F/M Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 2\frac{5}{8}"$.

Make one.



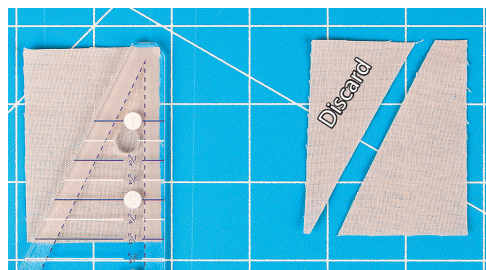

Using the Creative Grids Perfect Rectangle Ruler, cut the Fabric L rectangle as shown.



Make one Fabric L Facet.

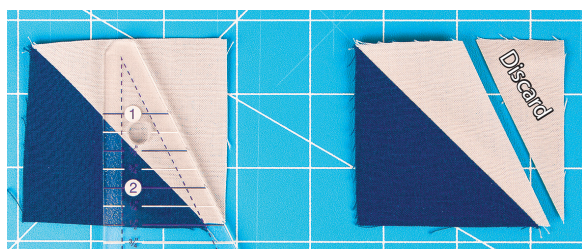
Turn the ruler over and cut the Fabric Q rectangle as shown.



Make one Fabric Q Facet.

Align the 2 ½" mark on the Creative Grids Perfect Rectangle Ruler with the bottom right corner of the Fabric F/R Unit. Trim the Fabric F/R Unit along the slanted side of the ruler.

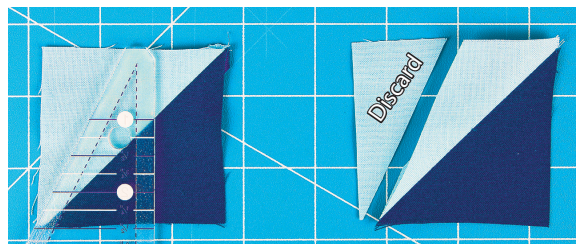
Pay close attention to the direction of the Fabric F/R Unit.



Make one.

Turn the ruler over and align the 2 ½" mark on the Creative Grids Perfect Rectangle Ruler with the bottom left corner of the Fabric F/M Unit. Trim the Fabric F/M Unit along the slanted side of the ruler.

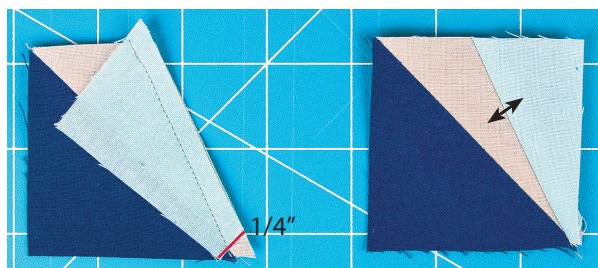
Pay close attention to the direction of the Fabric F/M Unit.



With right sides facing, align the Trimmed Fabric F/R Unit and the Fabric L Facet on the diagonal edge. Leave a ¼" triangle when matching seams.

Left Diamond Base Unit should measure 2 ½" x 2 ½".

Make one.

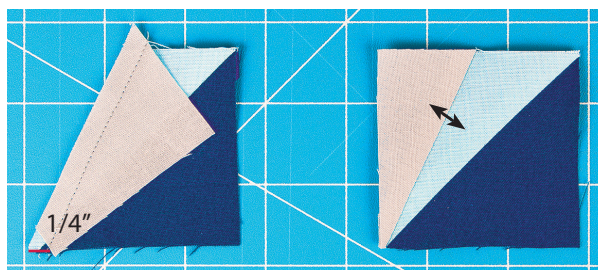


Make one.

With right sides facing, align the Trimmed Fabric F/M Unit and the Fabric Q Facet on the diagonal edge. Leave a ¼" triangle when matching seams.

Right Diamond Base Unit should measure 2 ½" x 2 ½".

Make one.



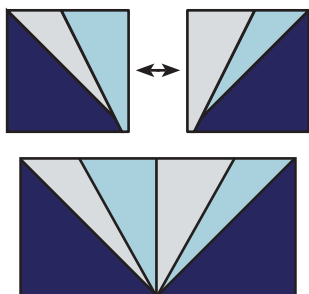

Assemble the Left Diamond Base Unit and the Right Diamond Base Unit.

Diamond Base Unit should measure $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$.

Make one.



Make one.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric K squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric K square with a Fabric G square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from the seam.

Carat One Unit should measure $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 1\frac{1}{2}"$.

Make one.



Make one.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric K square with a Fabric P square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from the seam.

Carat Two Unit should measure $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 1\frac{1}{2}"$.

Make two.



Make two.

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the remaining Fabric P square.

With right sides facing, layer the Fabric P square with a Fabric G square.

Stitch on the drawn line and trim $\frac{1}{4}"$ away from the seam.

Carat Three Unit should measure $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 1\frac{1}{2}"$.

Make one.



Make one.

Assemble the Carat One Unit, two Carat Two Units and the Carat Three Unit.

Pay close attention to unit placement.

Top Diamond Unit should measure $1\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$.

Make one.

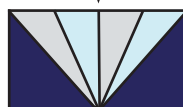


Make one.

Assemble the Top Diamond Unit and the Diamond Base Unit.

Diamond Unit should measure $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$.

Make one.



Make one.

Assemble two Fabric B rectangles and the Diamond Unit.
Wide Diamond Unit should measure 3 ½" x 9 ½".

Make one.

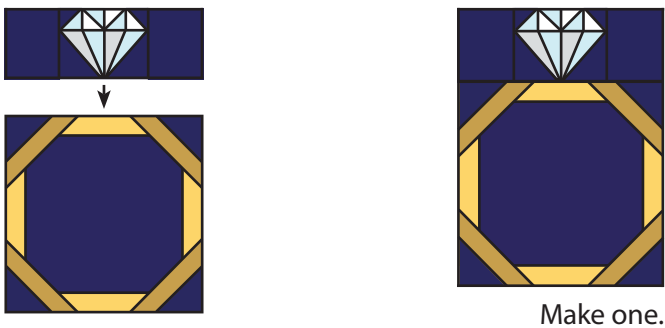


Diamond Ring Block:

Assemble the Wide Diamond Unit and the Band Unit.

Diamond Ring Block should measure 9 ½" x 12 ½".

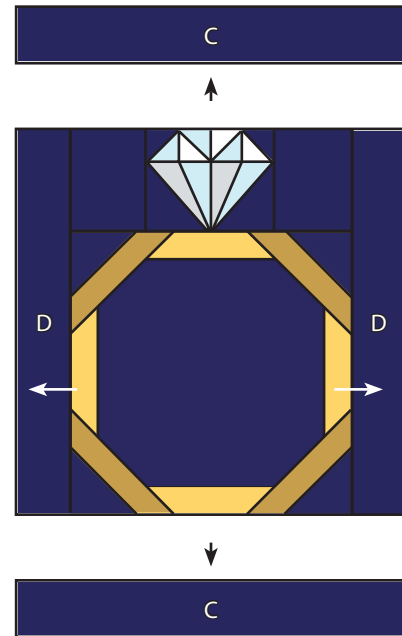
Make one.



Borders:

Attach side borders using the Fabric D strips.

Attach top and bottom borders using the Fabric C strips.



Finishing:

Piece the Fabric N strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
