## Two by Two Receiving Blanket

| Fabric Image | SKU | Yardage | Description | Quantity \& Size |  |  |

|  | C3833-AQUA | 1/4 yard | Quilt Center | A | 4 | $7{ }^{\text {7 }}$ squares |
|  | C3834-AQUA | 1/4 yard | Quilt Center | B | 4 | 7" squares |
|  | C3831-AQUA | 1/4 yard | Quilt Center | C | 4 | 7" squares |
|  | C3830-AQUA | 1/4 yard | Quilt Center | D | 4 | 7" squares |
|  | C3834-GRAY | 7/8 yard | Backing | E | 1 | 28" square |

Use $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seams and press as arrows indicate throughout.

## Quilt Center:

Assemble one Fabric A square, one Fabric B square, one Fabric $C$ square and one Fabric $D$ square as shown.
First Row should measure 7" $\times 261 / 21$.
Make one.

Assemble one Fabric C square, one Fabric D square, one Fabric A square and one Fabric $B$ square as shown.
Third Row should measure 7" x 26 ½".
Make one.


Assemble one Fabric B square, one Fabric C square, one Fabric D square and one Fabric A square as shown.
Fourth Row should measure 7" x 26 ½.
Make one.

## Two by Two Receiving Blanket

Assemble the First Row, the Second Row, the Third Row and the Fourth Row as shown.
Quilt Top should measure 26 ½" x $261 / 2 "$.


## Finishing:

With right sides facing, layer the Quilt Top with the Fabric E Square. Square up the Fabric E Square using the Quilt Top as a guide.
Pin in place as you are trimming the Fabric E Square to the same size as the Quilt Top.


To add curved edges use the 3 " section of the Creative Grids Non-Slip Multi-Size Curved Corner Cutter Ruler or the template provided on page 4.
Cut each corner using a rotary cutter.


Stitch around the Receiving Blanket using a $1 / 4$ " seam. Leave an 8" opening at the bottom. Backstitch at the beginning and end.
Turn the Receiving Blanket right side out.
Press the opening edges under $1 / 4$ " and press closed.


## Two by Two Receiving Blanket

Stitch around the Receiving Blanket $1 / 8$ " from the edge. Use matching thread. Backstitch at the beginning and end.

$\therefore$ Secure the quilt top and backing together by stitching - in the center seams of the quilt. Use matching thread. - Backstitch at the beginning and end.


If you do not have the Creative Grids Non-Slip Multi-Size Curved Corner Cutter Ruler use the template provided below or any kitchen bowl for your desired curve shape.
