Cream Background	1 ⅝ yards	3 ¼ yards	5 ⅝ yards	6 ⅝ yards
Red Solid and Binding	⅞ yard	1 ¾ yards	2 yards	2 ¾ yards
Aqua Solid	½ yard	1 yard	1 ¾ yards	1 ⅝ yards
Backing	2 ⅞ yards	3 ⅝ yards	5 ⅝ yards	7 ¾ yards

## One Block

Cream Background	4 - 2 ⅞" squares (A) 9 - 2 ½" squares (B)
Red or Aqua Solid	4 - 2 ⅞" squares (F) or (I) 8 - 2 ½" squares (G) or (J)

WOF = Width of Fabric

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# Sister's Choice Quilt Pattern

Sew using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and press as shown by arrows.

## Red Block Assembly:

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the Fabric A squares.

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric A square with a Fabric F square.

Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the drawn line.

Cut apart on the marked line.

Red Half Square Triangle should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Crib: Make 40. Lap: Make 80. Twin: Make 144. Queen: Make 168.

Assemble two Fabric G squares, two Red Half Square Triangles and one Fabric B square as shown.

Red Outer Row should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Crib: Make 10. Lap: Make 20. Twin: Make 36. Queen: Make 42.

Assemble two Red Half Square Triangles, two Fabric B squares and one Fabric G square as shown.

Red Inner Row should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Crib: Make 10. Lap: Make 20. Twin: Make 36. Queen: Make 42.

Assemble three Fabric B squares and two Fabric G squares as shown.

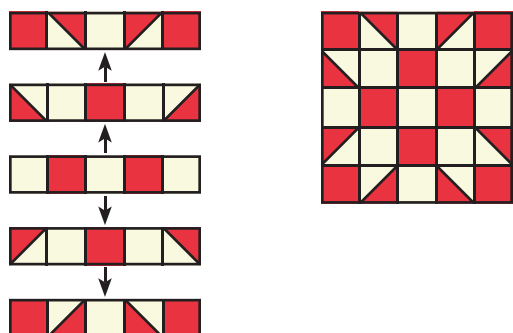
Red Center Row should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Crib: Make 5. Lap: Make 10. Twin: Make 18. Queen: Make 21.

Assemble two Red Outer Rows, two Red Inner Rows and one Red Center Row as shown.

Red Sister's Choice Block should measure  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Crib: Make 5. Lap: Make 10. Twin: Make 18. Queen: Make 21.

# Sister's Choice Quilt Pattern

## Aqua Block Assembly:

With right sides facing, layer a Fabric A square with a Fabric I square.

Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the drawn line.

Cut apart on the marked line.

Aqua Half Square Triangle should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Crib: Make 32. Lap: Make 80. Twin: Make 136. Queen: Make 168.

Assemble two Fabric J squares, two Aqua Half Square Triangles and one Fabric B square as shown.

Aqua Outer Row should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Crib: Make 8. Lap: Make 20. Twin: Make 34. Queen: Make 42.

Assemble two Aqua Half Square Triangles, two Fabric B squares and one Fabric J square as shown.

Aqua Inner Row should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Crib: Make 8. Lap: Make 20. Twin: Make 34. Queen: Make 42.

Assemble three Fabric B squares and two Fabric J squares as shown.

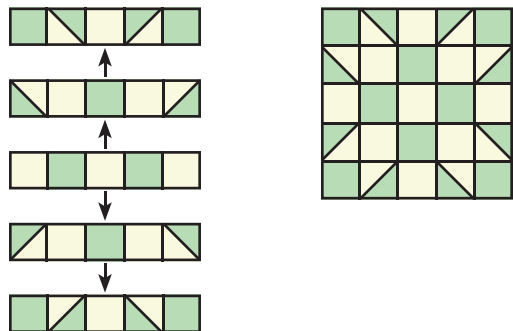
Aqua Center Row should measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Crib: Make 4. Lap: Make 10. Twin: Make 17. Queen: Make 21.

Assemble two Aqua Outer Rows, two Aqua Inner Rows and one Aqua Center Row as shown.

Aqua Sister's Choice Block should measure  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Crib: Make 4. Lap: Make 10. Twin: Make 17. Queen: Make 21.

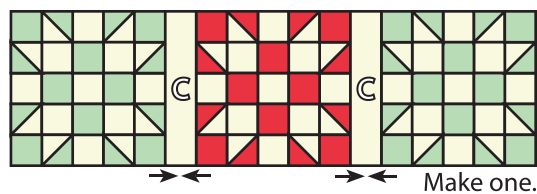
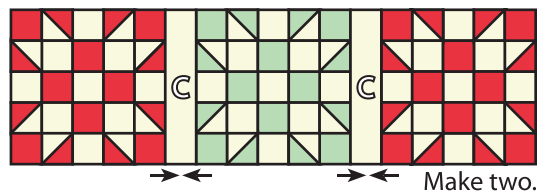


# Sister's Choice Quilt Pattern

## Crib Quilt Assembly:

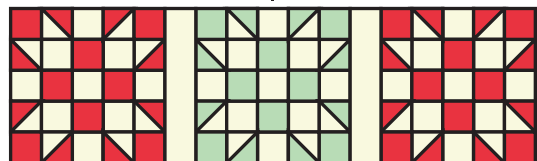
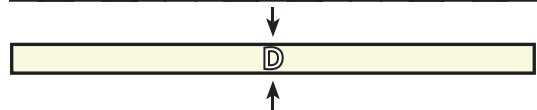
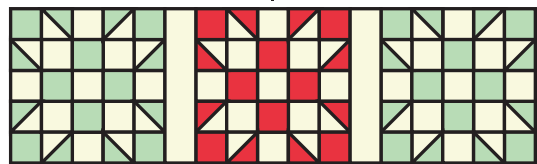
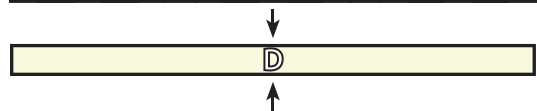
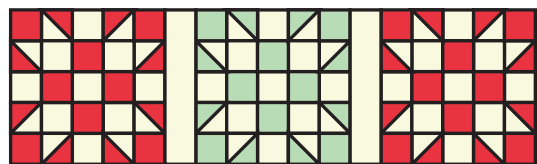
Assemble three Sister's Choice Blocks and two Fabric C rectangles as shown.

Quilt Rows should measure 10 1/2" x 34 1/2".



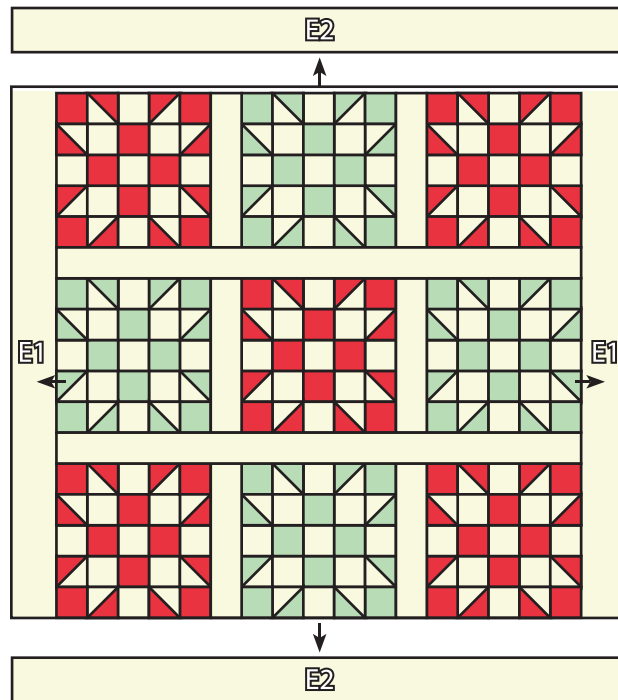
Assemble three Quilt Rows and two Fabric D strips as shown.

Quilt Center should measure 34 1/2" x 34 1/2".



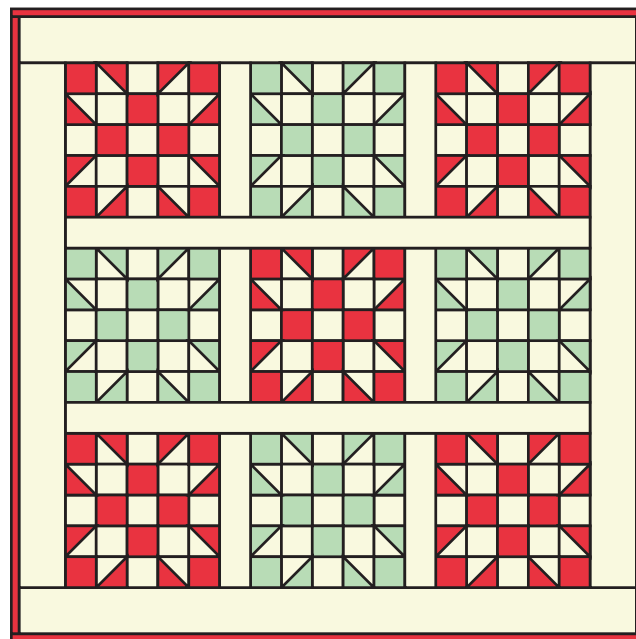
Attach side borders using Fabric E1 strips.

Attach top and bottom borders using Fabric E2 strips.



Piece Fabric H strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.

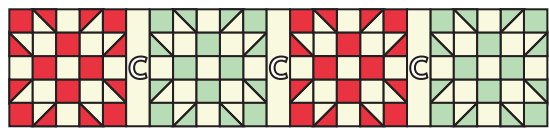


# Sister's Choice Quilt Pattern

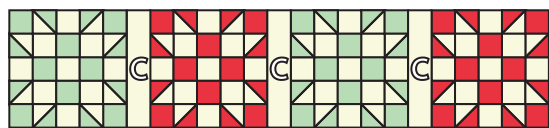
## Lap Quilt Assembly:

Assemble four Sister's Choice Blocks and three Fabric C rectangles as shown.

Quilt Rows should measure  $10\frac{1}{2}" \times 46\frac{1}{2}"$ .



Make three.

Piece Fabric D strips end to end and subcut into:

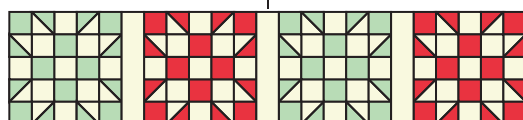
4 -  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 46\frac{1}{2}"$  strips.

Assemble five Quilt Rows and four Fabric D strips as shown.

Quilt Center should measure  $46\frac{1}{2}" \times 58\frac{1}{2}"$ .



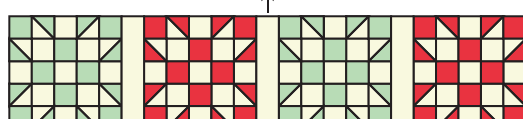
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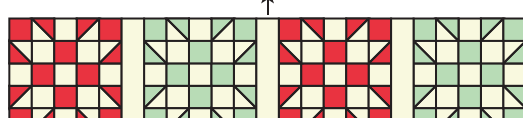

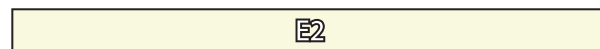
Piece Fabric E strips end to end and subcut into:

2 -  $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 58\frac{1}{2}"$  strips (E1)

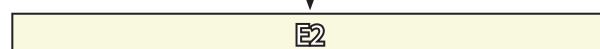
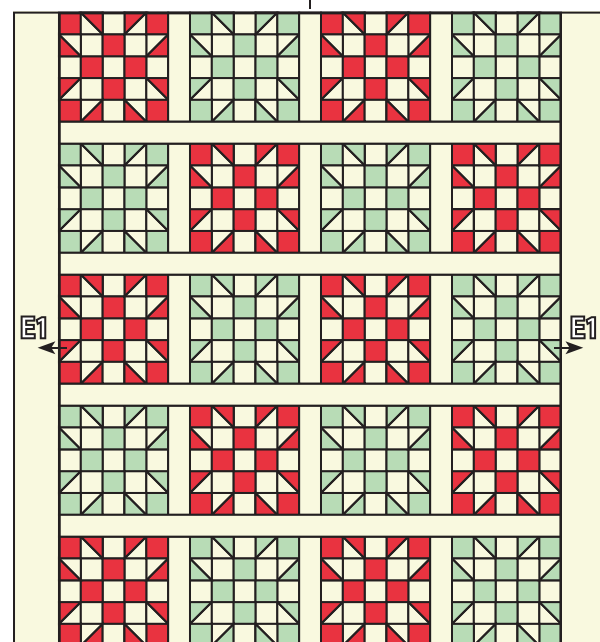
2 -  $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 54\frac{1}{2}"$  strips (E2)

Attach side borders using Fabric E1 strips.

Attach top and bottom borders using Fabric E2 strips.



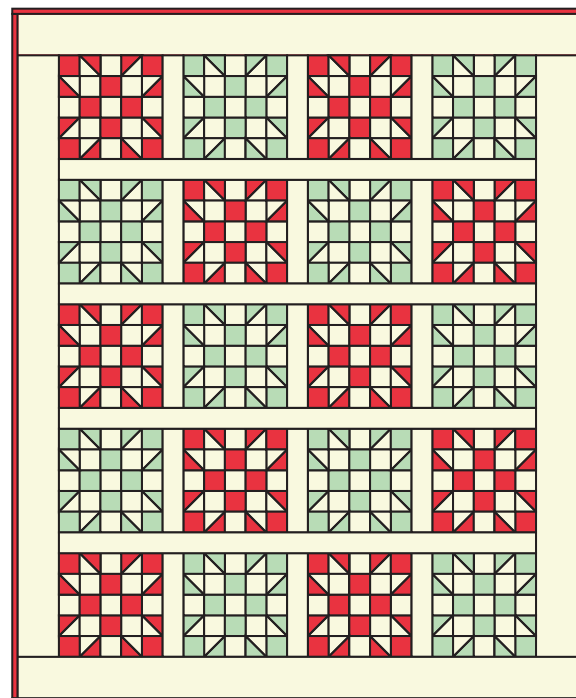

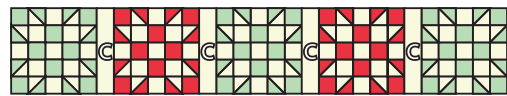
## Twin Quilt Assembly:

Assemble five Sister's Choice Blocks and four Fabric C rectangles as shown.

Quilt Rows should measure  $10\frac{1}{2}" \times 58\frac{1}{2}"$ .



Make four.



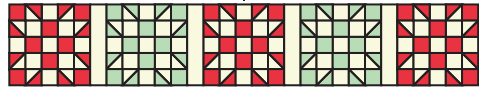
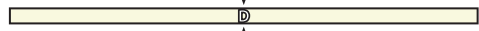
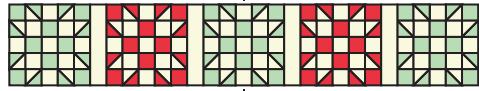
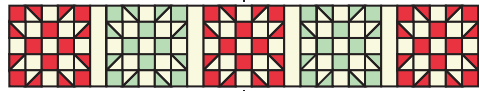
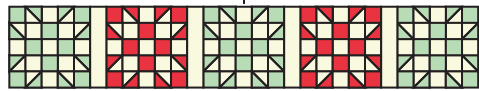
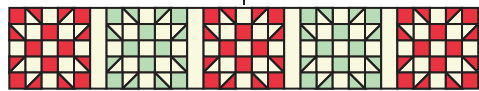
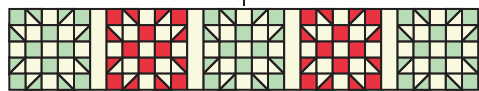
Make three.

Piece Fabric D strips end to end and subcut into:

6 -  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 58\frac{1}{2}"$  strips.

Assemble seven Quilt Rows and six Fabric D strips as shown.

Quilt Center should measure  $58\frac{1}{2}" \times 82\frac{1}{2}"$ .



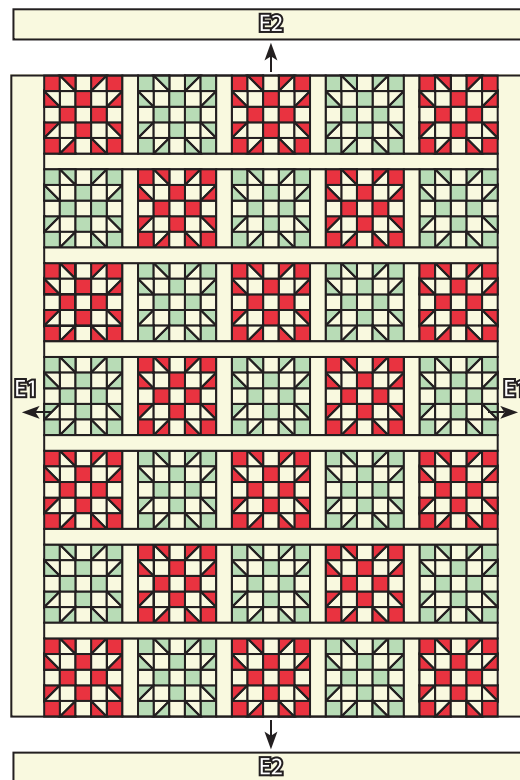
Piece Fabric E strips end to end and subcut into:

2 -  $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 82\frac{1}{2}"$  strips (E1)

2 -  $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 66\frac{1}{2}"$  strips (E2)

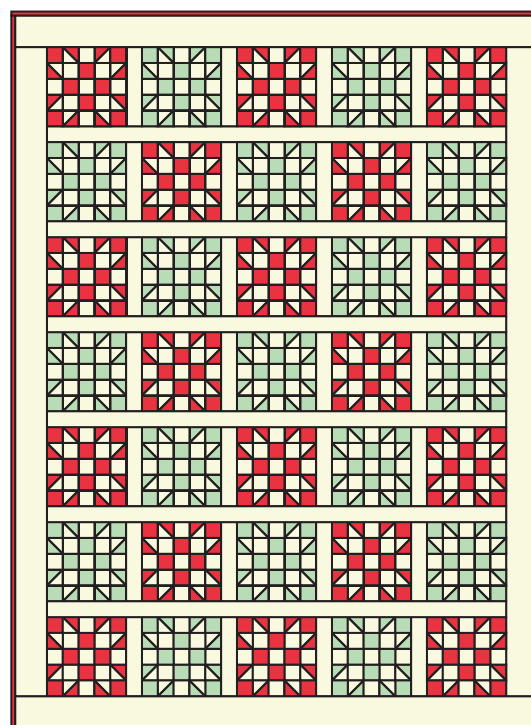
Attach side borders using Fabric E1 strips.

Attach top and bottom borders using Fabric E2 strips.



Piece Fabric H strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.



# Sister's Choice Quilt Pattern

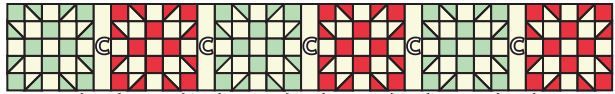
## Queen Quilt Assembly:

Assemble six Sister's Choice Blocks and five Fabric C rectangles as shown.

Quilt Rows should measure  $10\frac{1}{2}" \times 70\frac{1}{2}"$ .



Make four.



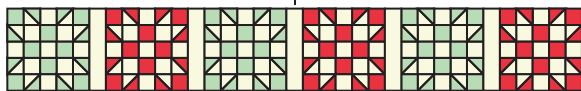
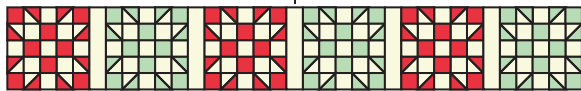
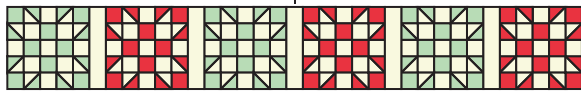
Make three.

Piece Fabric D strips end to end and subcut into:

6 -  $2\frac{1}{2}" \times 70\frac{1}{2}"$  strips.

Assemble seven Quilt Rows and six Fabric D strips as shown.

Quilt Center should measure  $70\frac{1}{2}" \times 82\frac{1}{2}"$ .

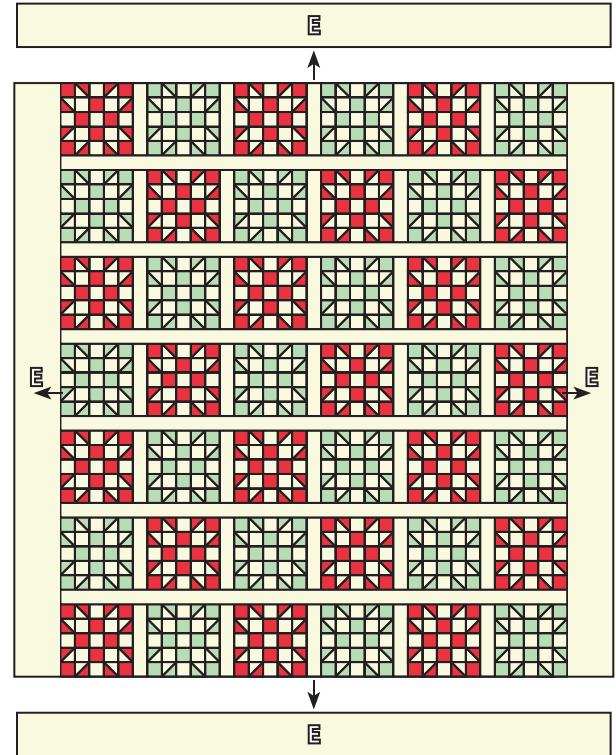


Piece Fabric E strips end to end and subcut into:

4 -  $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 82\frac{1}{2}"$  strips.

Attach side borders using Fabric E strips.

Attach top and bottom borders using Fabric E strips.



Piece Fabric H strips end to end for binding.

Quilt and bind as desired.
